AWARDS

1000 YARD SHOOT RULES AND REGULATIONS

RIFLE JURY - 3 People

- Jury checks and governs weights and rules.
- Jury will apply sticker and initial as proof of inspection.

SANDBAGS

- Shooters can use their own rifle rests, bipods or use supplied sandbags
- Front and rear rests must be separate

SHOT INTERVAL

- One minute per shot.

SIGHTER SHOTS

- One shot per shooter per event

CHAMBER SAFETY FLAGS

- Flags must be used at all times, unless the rifle is in a case or being fired.
- Rifles must be carried with muzzle up and action open with the flag in the chamber.

NOT ALLOWED

- No Professional Shooting Coats or Gloves
- No Slings, Sling Swivel Studs
- No Adjustable Butt Hook or Hand Stops

- Maximum 3/4" Muzzle
- Maximum Weight 10.5 lbs. with scope *
- Maximum Scope Setting 9 Power
- Factory or handloaded ammunition

SPORTING RIFLE CLASS

- Maximum 3/4" Muzzle
- Maximum Weight 10.5 lbs. with scope*
- Can Use Hand Loads
- Any Scope
- 5 shots

- Maximum Weight 17 lbs. with scope*
- 5 shots

UNLIMITED CLASS

- No Restrictions
- Must Be Shot Off Sandbags

HISTORY

In 1974 the first 1,000 yard shoot originated from a bet between four guys. One guy stating that a British 303 rifle, with iron sights and factory ammunition could be used to hit a target at 1,000 yards. The others strongly disagreed, saying that a 303 couldn't hit the broad side of a barn door.

The shooter persuaded a couple of local gun enthusiasts into setting up a 303 rifle . After testing several 303s, one was selected and equipped with a good aperture sight. Five boxes of ammunition later, the rifle was sighted in and finally ready to go.

In the early spring of 1975 the first 1,000 yard shoot took place on Decker Lake, where a 4'x4' target was set up on the ice. He shot five rounds, three hitting the target thus proving the validity of his statement. The 1,000 yard shoot has continued ever since. In memory of the first shoot, there is an off hand shoot at a 4'x4' target, with a special prize awarded.

Over the years the range has changed from various places in the area, to a permanent approved range at the Tweedsmuir Park Rod & Gun Club in Burns Lake, B. C.

The average attendees have increased over the years to 50+ competitors. Rain, snow or shine, this shoot has been a great attraction with competitors coming from as far away as Victoria and Whitehorse to the closer communities of Prince George, Houston, Smithers, Terrace, Fraser Lake, Endako and Burns Lake. In 1998 after completing the building of the range, it was named the "Thompson & Waldron Range" in honor of the two shooters who spent years getting permission to build the range.

This annual 1,000 yard shoot is held the last weekend in May. It was a single day event for years until the interest shown, prompted the Rod & Gun to turn it into a two day event, complete with overnight parking and campsites. There is also a supper and breakfast provided by the Tweedsmuir Park Rod & Gun Club.

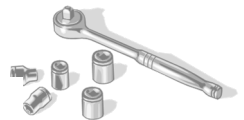
